



River Flow 2022 - Best Video Clip Contest

River Flow 2022 is holding a best video clip contest this year!

We are looking for brief video clips of anything exciting and related to River Flow 2022 themes. The videos will be shown in a session on the second day of the conference*. All attendees will have a chance to decide live on the winning entry using an interactive voting app. The winning video will be announced and replayed during the closing ceremony and the winning participant(s) will be awarded the “Best River Flow 2022 video” certificate.

*Participants can also opt-in to have their videos made publicly available on River Flow’s official YouTube channel with an accompanying description if desired.

Video entry details:

- Videos must be less than 60 s and in either .MP4 or .MOV format.
- Short silent clips or more elaborate productions with supporting audio are equally valid entries - whatever you decide is best as long as it is shorter than 60 s.
- Participants will have the duration of the video *plus* an additional amount of time to explain the video. The additional time will depend on the number of entries and will be divulged to participants by email shortly after the September 29th, 2022 intent to submit deadline.

Video clip contest: November 9th, 2022

Requirements for entry:

If you wish to participate, please send an email to j_dug@live.concordia.ca by [September 29th, 2022](#), indicating your intent. You will receive a confirmation email containing a link to a OneDrive folder in which you will need to supply the following items by October 15th, 2022:

1. A 60 s or less video file (.MP4 or .MOV format, 200 Mb file size limit)
2. A thumbnail image representative of your video
3. A completed entry form (available from River Flow 2022’s website under Video Contest)
